

## **Advanced Conservation Intern – Sculpture**

**Department:** Conservation

**Intern Title:** Advanced Conservation Intern: Objects Conservation

**Overview:** This internship will focus on allowing the advanced student in objects conservation to carry out a vast amount of varying conservation treatments. The collections to be conserved include outdoor sculpture, Plains Indian material, and other three-dimensional objects. The intern will function as a member of the conservation department and will carry out their own examination, documentation, treatment, and dialogues with curatorial staff.

**Level of responsibility:** Reports to Chief Conservator.

**Specific duties and responsibilities:** Work with the Chief Conservator to select objects for treatment. Carry out examination, documentation, and treatment. Explain activities to VIP tours passing through the lab. Teach pre-program interns some fundamental objects conservation techniques.

**Qualifications:** The qualified intern will have completed at least one year of a master's program in conservation and be headed towards a major in objects conservation.

**Institutional Goals and Benefits:** To participate in the training of conservation professionals. Further the conservation treatment of BBHC collections.
