Overview: This internship provides an opportunity for experience in the varied responsibilities of Multimedia and Museum video production, including filming, scriptwriting, editing, distribution through electronic media, and archiving.

Level of Responsibility: *Reports to* Multimedia Coordinator

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

Specific duties include, but may not be limited to:

- Independently and assist in filming, lighting and audio recording throughout the museum and the greater Yellowstone area, covering educational programming such as the new raptor program, educational talks, filming nature and interviews.
- Searching through the Museum archives for appropriate images and video for multimedia projects.
- Posting and organizing video content on the Center's website and social media. This includes figuring out what works on the web and helping developing better content for the future.
- Creating professional logs of video material and improving organization of video archives.
- Video editing using Final Cut Pro and Adobe Premiere.

- May require occasional travel as far away as Yellowstone National Park
